Bunbury was the venue for the very first Australian Underwater Hockey Titles and between it and the neighbouring regional towns of Collie (the first Australian Champions), Busselton and Margaret River, WA has seen an explosion of interest in the Southwest Region.


The Pool was upgraded in 2014 to incorporate World class UWH courts ready for these specific events.

Two full size two meter deep playing courts with fast gloss tiles, hardwall Perspex barriers, in water subbing and four 25m lane warmup enable Bunbury to build on its proud underwater hockey heritage.

Medical Support Lifeguards will be present every day during the competition for minor concerns.


Filming: The current plan is to utilise the UHA Filming software to broadcast live games on YouTube.




